



Polasaí Cúram Pearsanta agus Leithris

Páistí le Sainriachtanais Leithris/Cúraim Phearsanta acu:

- I ngach cás ina dteastaíonn cúnamh ó dhalta an leithreas a úsáid/Cúram Pearsanta, beidh cruinniú, sula dtosaíonn an páiste ar scoil
- Beidh Tuismitheoirí/Caomhnóirí, Príomhoide, Múinteoir Ranga, CRB, agus más cuí, an dalta, i láthair
- Soiléireofar sainriachtanais chúraim an pháiste, agus conas a fhreastalóidh an scoil orthu
- Aithneofar baill fhoirne atá baint acu leis an gcúram seo
- Tabharfar cuntas scríofa ar sholáthar d'ócáidí ina mbeidh ball foirne as láthair (e.g. ní bheidh baint ag ionadaí le cúram pearsanta). Pléifear aon athrú pearsanra leis an dalta, más cuí
- Beidh beirt bhall foirne i láthair agus iad ag déileáil le riachtanais Chúraim Phearsanta
- Pléifear aon athruithe leis an tuismitheoir/caomhnóir agus leis an dalta agus beidh taifead scríofa i gcomhad an dalta
- An oiread agus is féidir, beidh and pháiste bainte in aithin a riachtanais p(h)earsanta, mianta, athruithe srl.
- Coinneofar cóip scríofa den chomhaontú faoi chomhad an dalta
- Cuirfear tuismitheoirí ar an eolas faoi aon athruithe ó nósanna imeachta comhaontaithe
- Beidh dínit, príobháideacht agus sábháilteacht an dalta curtha chun tosaigh maidir le riachtanais chúraim phearsanta
- Beidh lámhainní cosanta á gcaitheamh ag an bhfoireann

Timpistí Leithris:

- Ag cruinnithe ionductúcháin na naíonán sóisearach, tabharfar cuntas ar nósanna imeachta na scoile do thuismitheoirí, agus iarrfar orthu chur isteach i scríbhinn má tá mianta ar leith acu maidir le timpistí leithris. Breithneoidh an scoil an aighneacht agus cuirfidh sí na tuismitheoirí ar an eolas má tá sí inghlactha
- Coinneofar fo-éadaí glana, bríste srl sa scoil le haghaidh 'timpistí leithris'
- Ar an gcéad dul síos, tairgfear éadaí úra don dalta agus beifear ag súil go nglanfaidh agus go n-athróidh sé/sí iad féin
- Más rud é nach bhfuil an pháiste in ann iad féin a ghlanadh nó a athrú, leanfar an nós imeachta atá leagtha amach ag tuismitheoirí agus a nglacann an scoil leis, má theastaíonn



- Más gá don fhoireann an pháiste a ghlanadh /a athrú i gcás timpistí leithris, freastalóidh beirt bhall foirne, a bhfuil aithne acu/aici ar an leanbh air/uirthi
- Cuirfear tuismitheoirí ar an eolas faoi na timpistí seo
- Ba chóir taifead den eachtra, mar atá leagtha amach in E (thuas) a choinneáil

Intimate Care and Toileting Policy

Children with Specific Toileting/Intimate Care Needs:

- In all situations where a pupil needs assistance with Toileting/Intimate Care, a meeting will be convened, after enrolment and before the child starts school
- Parents, Guardians, Principal, Class Teacher, ANA, and if appropriate, the pupil, will attend
- The specific care needs of the child, and how the school will meet them, will be clarified
- Personnel involved in this care will be identified
- Provision for occasions when a member/s of staff is/are absent will be outlined (e.g. Substitute ANA's will not be involved in intimate care). Any change of personnel will be discussed with the pupil, if appropriate
- Two members of staff will be present when dealing with Intimate Care needs
- Any changes will be discussed with parent/guardian and pupil and noted in writing in the pupil's file
- As far as possible, the pupil will be involved in identification of his/her personal requirements, wishes, changes etc
- A written copy of the agreement will be kept on the pupil's file
- Parents will be notified of any changes from agreed procedures
- At all times the dignity, privacy and safety of the pupil will be paramount in addressing intimate care needs
- Staff will wear protective gloves

Toileting Accidents:

- At the junior infant induction meetings, the school procedures will be outlined to parents, and they will be asked to submit in writing if they have specific wishes regarding toileting accidents. The school will consider the submission and will inform the parents if it acceptable
- A supply of clean underwear, track-suit bottoms etc will be kept in the school for 'wetting accidents'



- In the first instance, the pupil will be offered fresh clothing and will be expected to clean and change themselves
- If, for any reason, the child is unable to clean or change themselves, the procedure outlined by parents and accepted by the school will be followed, if applicable
- If staff must clean /change the child in the case of 'wetting' accidents, two members of staff, familiar to the child will attend to him/her
- Parents will be notified of these accidents
- A record of the incident, as outlined in E (above) should be kept
